Few places on earth provide a greater concentration of natural marvels and archeological treasures. With a history spanning the millennia and cities as new as tomorrow, Jordan beckons.

Only, a half hour drive from Amman to Jerash, an entire Roman provincial city. A virtual outdoor museum complete with remarkably well preserved boulevards, temples, fountains and a unique forum. It was an administrative and cultural center of the Roman Decapolis.

Petra is a name from antiquity that fills all expectations. This tiny commercial crossroads was lost to mankind for centuries. Now, behold it in all its glory. Temples, monuments and grave sites, in the style of the Assyrians, Greeks and Romans, all carved into the solid sandstones of the mountains. Like nature's palette the magnificent colors range from the rose-red to maroon, vermilion, russet and ocher ... and change with the sun. Jordan offers tolerance and hospitality - reflection of its Bedouin heritage.

Wednesday:

Meet at Queen Alia International Airport and assistance with Jordanian immigration and customs formalities or join this tour in Amman. Drive to Jerash, the best-preserved city of Roman times, to visit its theaters, temples, churches and colonnaded streets. Then continue to Ajloun to tour the 12th century Saracen Castle built by one of Saladin's lieutenants in the campaign against the Crusaders. You'll have overnight in Amman.

Thursday:

Drive southwards along the King's way to Petra, visiting Madaba with the oldest map of the Holy Land, and its Mosaic School, Mt. Nebo and the alleged burial site of Moses overlooking the Dead sea and the Jordan Valley; then drive through the magnificent scenery of Wadi Mujib to Kerak to visit the Crusader Castle (stop for optional lunch), overnight in Petra.

Friday

A full day to visit the many sites of Petra, this city that was carved into the rose-red Sharah Mountains by the Nabatean and lost to civilization until rediscovery by the Swiss Burkhardt, walk through the siq, a narrow and winding fissure between the cliffs, to reach the Treasury, the Roman Theater, the Courts and Qasr Bint Pharaoun, Temple of the Winged Lion and other monuments. A break for optional lunch or you may wish to climb up to the Monastery, overnight in Petra.

Saturday

You'll visit Wadi Rum Desert (with a short ride in a 4x4 vehicle) and its awesome moon-like landscape, where the film "Lawrence of Arabia" was shot. Return to Amman on the Dessert Highway (stop en route for optional lunch) or continue to the Araba Crossing and assistance with departure formalities or to Aqaba
