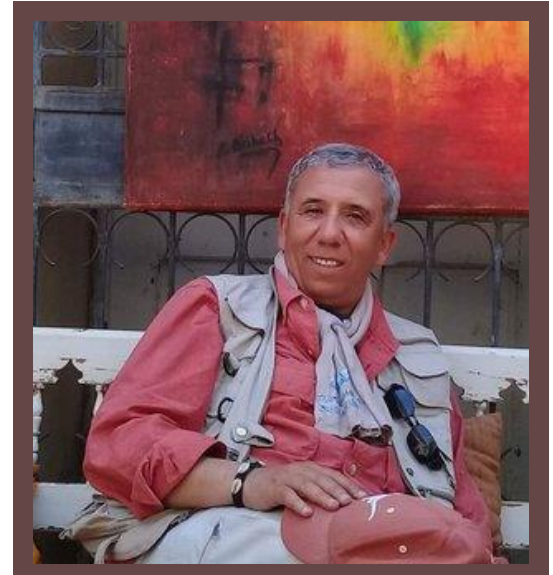


About Mohamed Halouani
