
DISCOVER THE WONDERS

Day 01 Arrive in Cairo (EGYPT)



Upon arrival at **Cairo International Airport**, meet and transfer to *Ramses Hilton Hotel* or similar for check-in, and overnight.

Note: Standard check-in time is 3:00 pm. if you arrive prior to the set date or early morning of the arrival day; an extra hotel night needs to be booked.

Day 02





Begin the drive in the early morning to the **Bahariya Oasis**, surrounded by black hills made up of ferruginous quartzite and dolerite, and famous for its 398 mineral & sulfur springs, some of which have temperatures reaching up to 45 degrees and are famous for their healing effects. Upon arrival in **Bawiti**, the capital of the

Oasis occupying a hillside transfer to *Tzila Baharia Lodge* or similar for check-in, enjoy lunch & rest.

In the late afternoon, head to visit **El Meftella Mountain**, **Salt Lake**, **Dest** (Pyramid Mountain) & **Maghrafa Mountain**, continue to **Bir el Ghaba** & El **Matar warm springs** and have the opportunity to swim. if time permits, we may visit the English Mountain at sunset time. Here, the old English out post was used by British troops as it showed strategic views of the area, after to enjoy the sunset with amazing Bedouin tea and snacks will back to hotel. Return to the *Lodge* for dinner and overnight. **(B,L,D)**

Day 03

Bahariya oasis - White desert (Farafra)

Enjoy breakfast then begin the day with a drive to visit the **Black Desert** surrounding Bahariya Oasis, formed by the erosion of the mountains, which have spread a layer of black powder and stones over the peaks and plateaus, it looks like a landscape straight out of Hades.

Explore **Gabal el Marsos** (Divided Mountain), and then drive off Road to the small Bedouin village "**El Hez**", and the water spring, where can enjoy swimming and have lunch. After spending some time, continue the drive to the White Desert area (100 miles) stopping en route at the **Crystal Mountain**, a unique structure. It is made entirely of calcite crystal that combine altogether to create a striking ridge standing up out of the deser and enjoy the beautiful shining stone and small cave. Continue the drive to **El Mattar area** and transfer to *Sheherazade fixed camp* for check-in, dinner and overnight **(B,L,D)**

Day 04 White desert

After enjoying the sunrise in the beautiful desert, begin the drive to **Aqabat** off Road area stopping en route by the **Hole mountain**, then continue driving to the Great karaween sand dunes, enjoy the driving through the sand dunes and also, we have availability for the sand boarding adventure there. After the nice time by the dunes will driving on the way to the Magic spring "**Ain El serw**", the subterranean cypress spring -in the white desert within the north of Frafra oasis could be a fountain of water that continues to be dry till any living creature approaches it and acquire almost it, either somebody's, an animal's, or maybe a bird's. they start to dry out step by step till they disappear and evaporate fully.

Enjoy a delicious picnic lunch near the water spring, then after lunch continue the drive to the white desert, stopping en route by the **big** and **small valleys** and also **Henes Valley**, Visit the oldest **Acacia tree** in the Ain Khadra oases then stop at the **tents valley** for a photo opportunity before arriving at the **White Desert National Park**. The park is the site of large white chalk rock formations created through erosion by wind and sand. It is also the site of cliffs at the northern end of the

Farafra Depressions. The park serves as the refuge for various animals, including the endangered Rhim gazelle and the vulnerable Dorcas gazelle, as well as barbary sheep, red and fennec foxes. Enjoy the sunset over the exquisite sands of the desert, and a delicious BBQ dinner. Overnight at the camp. **(B,L,D)**

Day 05 White Desert - Cairo



Enjoy breakfast and drive back to Cairo and transfer to *Ramses Hilton Hotel* for check-in, free rest of the day at leisure and overnight. **(B)**

Day 06 Cairo - USA



Transfer to the airport in the very early morning for your flight back to the US. **(B)**
